Dr. Betsy Keller PhD

Dr. Betsy Keller, PhD is an exercise physiologist and professor in the Department of Sports Medicine at Ithaca College in New York. She received her M.Sc and PhD in exercise science and has over a decade of clinical experience with patients with ME/CFS. Dr. Keller is also one of fifteen experts selected to work on a committee to develop new guidelines for ME/CFS by the Institute of Medicine (IOM) in the United States. She will discuss her research protocol involving using VO2max testing with gas exchange on two consecutive days. Her findings demonstrate that the response to cardiopulmonary exercise tests is typically abnormal in these patients.

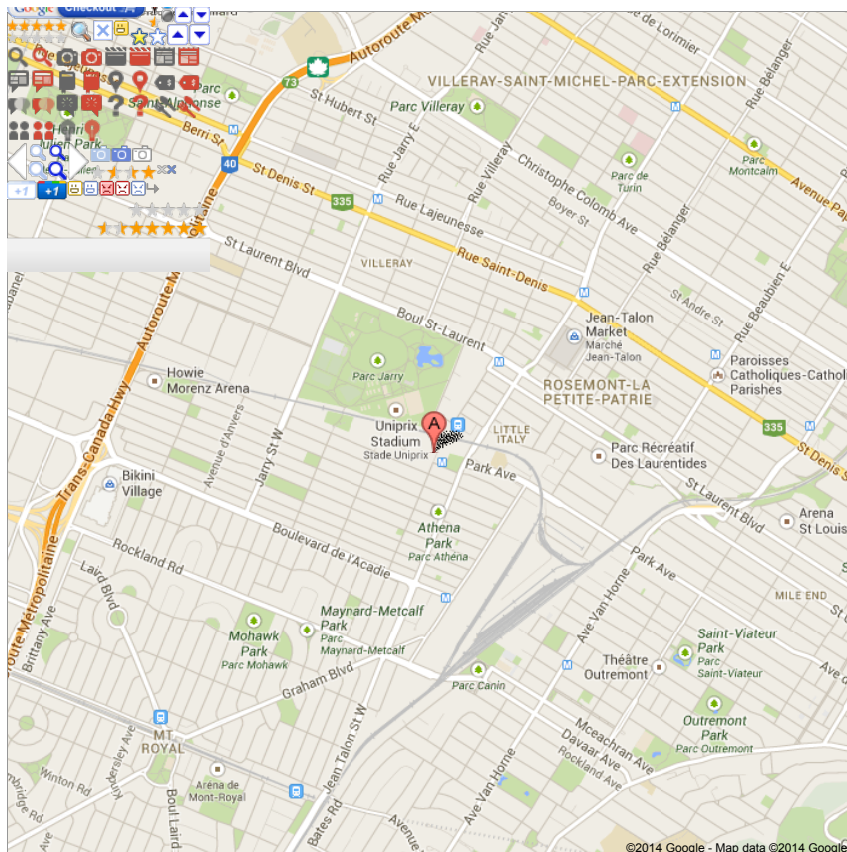

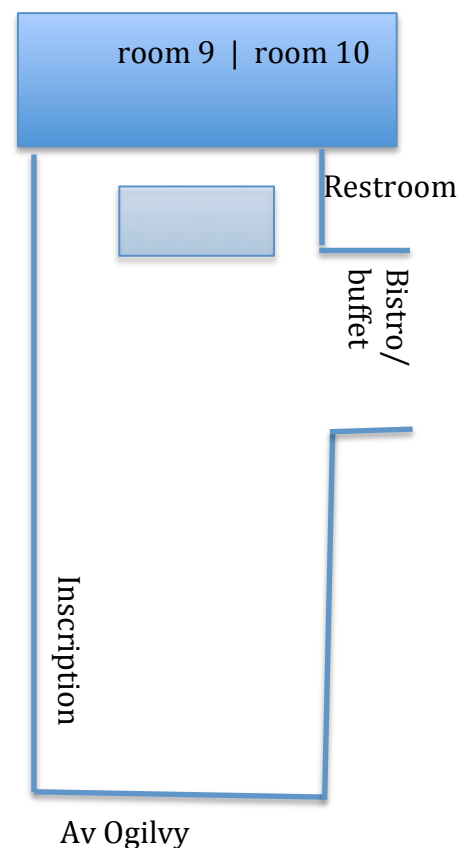
